
Disable C-State reporting with J1900 CPU


If you experience problems with occasional freezing of the computer with Windows 10, disabling C-state reporting will most likely solve this.

- 1. Enter BIOS with when the Tipro logo shows.
- 2. Go to menu: Advanced > CPU configuration:




3. Then choose DISABLED for CPU C state report. Leave the rest.
